The anonymity of the internet allows a certain amount of perceived expertise to be created by a flashy website and slick ads.

Marketing does not a homeopathy master make.

Right now, newbies are popping up everywhere. Perhaps they are just regurgitating information they read from a book somewhere. Perhaps they are pirating information from others.

I have looked at some of the websites and found mistakes. That concerns me. Homeopathy's reputation hinges on the integrity of those on the front lines of the paradigm. As the space becomes crowded with “posers,” it begs the question, “Whom do you trust?”

I trust the homeopathy masters.

I trust homeopaths (whether homeopathic practitioners, M.D.s, naturopaths or even lay practitioners) who have taken cases for a long time. I trust homeopaths who have undergone rigorous training – such as the immersive training from The Academy of Practical Homeopathy®. My goodness, some other

schools don't require their graduates to pass a pathophysiology module or study Dr. Samuel Hahnemann's seminal Organon, the book detailing Hahnemann's homeopathic philosophy.
